In full and final settlement of the above-referenced grievance, Horizon Air Industries, Inc. (the "Company") and the Association of Flight Attendants — CWA (the "Union") agree as follows:

- The Company will continue to credit the uniform replacement bank of Flight Attendants on January 1 of each year in accordance with the terms of Article 12.D.2 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement ("CBA").
- Even though the credit will be issues on January 1 of each year, Flight Attendants may not be able to access or spend the credit on January 1 due to administrative delays associated with processing the credit.
- 3. In December of each year, the Company shall inform Flight Attendants via FAIF of the following: "On January 1, the Company shall credit your uniform replacement bank as set forth in Article 12.D.2 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement. Funds may not be immediately visible in your account or available for use due to processing timelines. If you do not see the credit in your account by January 15th, please contact your inflight leadership team."
- 4. The Union will withdraw the grievance without prejudice or precedent.
