Settlement of AFA Grievance No. 06-99-02-46-15 (Electronic Vacation Bidding)

In full and final settlement of Grievance No.06-99-02-46-15, the Association of Flight Attendants and Horizon Air Industries, Inc. (the Company), hereby agree to the following:

- 1. The Company will notify the Association of all future changes to computer programming used by Flight Attendants that affect scheduling (e.g., bidding, trip trades, SAP, sick-leave use and vacation bidding/trading/use).
- 2. The Association may send one (1) representative to participate in any meetings (in person or electronic) regarding such changes, with adequate time for the Association to send a representative to the meeting(s).
- 4. The Company will absorb all flight-pay loss and expenses for the representative and will ensure that adequate flying is dropped if necessary.
- 5. AFA will withdraw the grievance.
