Please take a moment out of your day to review the Safety information included in our contract on our website AFAHorizon.org, Article 26 beginning on page 151. In Article 26, you will find contractual verbiage pertaining to Fatigue Reporting, Accidents/ Incidents, and New Equipment and Changes to Inflight Service. Some quick highlights of important information in this article are:

- Pay and Occurrence protections during an Accident or Incident during your trip.
- · Hearing Protection and testing.
- Questions/Answers to incorporate in your Fatigue Report.
- Fatigue Protections and reminders of time constraints when filing a Fatigue Report.

These are some of the insightful content that has been established for our protections. Reading, understanding, and knowing your contract is of the utmost importance to gain knowledge on our workgroup's rights and protections.

The Safety Committee would like to highlight Article 26 as we head into the winter months - when irregular operations can contribute to safety issues, such as fatigue.

The goal is for every QX Flight Attendant to be able to advocate for themselves and know the verbiage well enough to use their voice intelligently. Knowledge is power. Our Contract is here to educate and protect us.
