Wanted to take a moment and introduce myself. My name is Bryan Grosvold, a Seattle Based Flight attendant and the Local Council 16 Air Safety Health and Security (ASHS) Committee Chair. I have been flying for Horizon Air since 2006, first based in Denver Co and have been Seattle based ever since. My introductory AFA assignment was the procurement of food and beverage carts with dual doors and room for two top bins for both flight attendants to operate safely. I transferred to the Safety committee shortly thereafter.

I wanted to give you a brief peek into the behind the scenes work that we, as ASHS volunteers do for you, our fellow AFA members daily. The ASHS committee works with other AFA committees to deal with issues that affect our daily lives at work. The issues vary from onboarding of our new uniforms, to the arrival of the E-175 on property a few years ago. We work closely with our Inflight Service Committee. That work has increased significantly recently as the company seeks to reintroduce food and service items in our current health environment. Additionally, every month the ASHS Committee reviews reports that you, our fellow flight attendants have filed. As a committee, we meet jointly with the company and FAA to identify any trends that we see as a result of the reports. We provide recommendations to leadership as we consider risks associated with the changes that we are going through daily.

The committee's goal is to fly as much as possible to experience what these changes mean and how they impact us. This firsthand knowledge is a valuable base to draw on, as we advocate to keep everyone safe. We do appreciate you taking the time to report items via the ReportIt App that come up on the line or through ASAP. This is crucial and allows us to demonstrate needed action by the reports. The information creates a trend the company can track. The IMD provides a great tool that allows you to document something through the notes section and quickly transfer and submit it to the company once your flight is done. Please keep these reports coming!
