Hello Fellow Flight Attendant's,

The Air Safety, Health and Security Committee wanted to give an update on the monthly Safety tiein with the AAG Cabin Safety Manager.

The QX AFA Safety Committee had a long list of items and wanted to share the question/answer portion of the safety meeting.

Question:

1. Follow up on written verbiage onboard the aircraft regarding flight attendant protection from being videotaped/photographed against their will.


Answer; Yes, that verbiage is now found in the onboard Main Cabin Inflight Guide. It's a great tool to use if a passenger is videoing/photographing you against your approval.

- 2. ETQ "Entry Type" (aka, Reporting in the Report It App). Currently, the data is inputted by the analysts perception of the narrative. AFA's ask is to have a mode defined/assorted description to choose from for their specific report. Ex; Turbulence, Door Event and Fatigue.
- **Answer**; Yes, possible to see some Safety Reporting enhancements later this year. An example would be. If a flight attendant encountered turbulence, there would be a turbulence link to click, streamlining reporting a bit.
- 3. Additional AED pads placed onboard each aircraft, so that the AED may be used on the leg back to a maintenance base, possibly saving someone's life.

Answer; Agreed that it's a good idea. More discussion for a Q2, possibility.

 AFA has asked to to get clear/defined Medical emergency procedures off of the aircraft. (EX:Pax in a jetway.) CRM/Communication to Pilots/GSA's Location of emergency medical equipment/how to detach equipment, procedures to contact medics quickly (cockpit crew) number of on-site airport medics at each gate.

Answer; There's a meeting scheduled to discuss these topics with AAG Safety/QX Safety (P&P)/AFA.(Next week)



Answer; AAG Cabin Safety Manager discussed door data slide to the monthly safety meeting/monitoring the issue.

6. Mask Demo(Keeping our mask on) **Answer**; Under discussion

- 7. Current QX Seat blocks. **Answer**; 175- Seat 1C 400- 1A and 1B (Row 1) All jumpseats
- Medaire follow up checklist for Covid Exposure/notification to quarantine while on duty.
 Answer; AAG sent Medaire an email. AFA is awaiting a response.
