We are at a point in time that a decision needs to be made regarding the jump seat on our aircraft. Since the start of the COVID-19 pandemic, safety measures have been implemented to help protect flight attendants from exposure to COVID-19. One safety aspect that was executed was the blocking of the ACM jump seat. Currently, the loads on our flights are increasing steadily and are projected to continue to do so with the continuation of Spring Break travel. Commuters are encountering challenges getting a seat on flights. Others, who are deadheading, would rather sit in the jump seat with the B Flight Attendant than with a passenger they don't know. And finally, vaccines are becoming more available. Only very recently has the Covid vaccine become more widely available in all states where we are based and live. At this time, we would like to know if you prefer opening up the aft ACM jump seat effective on April 1<sup>st</sup> or delay an additional thirty days to allow everyone the opportunity, if they choose, to become fully vaccinated before opening up the jump seat.
